West Dean College is situated 6 miles north of Chichester, West Sussex, 65 miles from London. The nearest railway station is in Chichester. There is a regular train service from London's Victoria station to Chichester (on the Portsmouth line), the journey taking about 1 hour and 40 minutes. The College minibus will operate a shuttle service between the station and the College, picking up from the ticket hall side at 9.30; 10.30; 11.30; 12.30; 13.30; 14.30 and 15.30. The return journey will leave West Dean College on the hour. The driver's mobile telephone number is 07765 55 43 12 in case you have any queries.

The number 60 bus leaves from the bus terminus near the train station, and stops in West Dean village. Alternatively, there are black cabs outside the station.

For those travelling by car, the College is situated north of Chichester on the A286 Chichester-to-Midhurst road. The Journey from Chichester town centre takes 15 minutes. There is ample car parking provided at the College.
