## GIFT AID - NOTES TO DONORS

### Gift Aid - notes for donors

Your payment to this Registered Charity can be treated as a Gift Aid Donation. If you are a UK taxpayer, we can reclaim the tax paid on your donation at no extra cost to you. This means that a further 28p in every £1 can be reclaimed by the Charity and put to good use.

- You must pay an amount of income tax or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax the charity reclaims on your donations in the last or current tax year. (The tax reclaimed is currently 28p for each £1 you give.)
- If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return. Simply retain your receipt as proof of your donation.
- The information you give will remain confidential and will not be passed to any organisation other than HM Revenue and Customs.
