TITLE: FESTIVE FLOWERS AND FLORAL DECORATIONS

TUTORS: SUE HINGSTON AND SASHA CRABB **LEVEL:** BEGINNERS/INTERMEDIATE

AIMS OF COURSE:

These 1-day workshops aim to provide students with the knowledge and skill to create a variety of stunning festive Christmas and party arrangements. *Please note that each workshop day has to be booked individually.*

WHAT STUDENTS SHOULD LEARN OR ACHIEVE:

On each day students will complete two different floral designs from the following list: a door wreath; a table arrangement; a garland and mantelpiece arrangement. So if students would like to attend both days they will complete four designs to take home.

MAIN TOPICS COVERED, INCLUDING PRACTICAL TECHNIQUES IF ANY:

Making two arrangements on each one-day workshop.

TEACHING METHOD:

Group demonstrations of modern techniques and innovative ideas for festive, floral designs with individual help from the tutors and an individual review of the completed piece.

GENERAL TIMETABLE:

2 pieces will be completed each day to take home.

STUDENT PREPARATION FOR COURSE IF ANY:

All the materials will be provided by the tutors; however students are free to bring extra materials to incorporate in their designs. All students must bring floristry scissors, notebook, pen, vases and a camera to photograph their work if they wish. As students will complete bulky designs, a car or private transport would perhaps be convenient.

The tutors instruct students in health and safety issues relevant to this course. There are no health and safety restrictions on access to this studio/teaching space in the absence of the tutor.
